

## Wool Guide

Congratulations! You have bought a beautiful 100% natural product with unique properties. Our tips on use, care and maintenance:

- \*Wool is naturally antibacterial, dirt-repellent and self-cleaning.
- \* If you want to freshen up your plaid, airing it outside is often enough. \*
- \*Washing is not recommended because the wool will felt and lose its lightness. If it is really necessary, find a good dry cleaner.
- \*Wool has a natural scent. If you don't like it, you can use a fragrance spray. More tips on reducing the smell can be found online on our website(s).
- \* If your plaid has just been made, loose fibres may come off. This reduces with use, as the fibres become more attached. So you need patience and lots of snuggling!
- \*Want to speed up the attachment process? Lightly spray your plaid with water using a plant sprayer. Put your wool product briefly (!) in the dryer. After 2-3 minutes, the wool will be better attached due to heat and friction.
- \*It's better to cut lint off than to pull it off.
- \*The size of your plaid is always approximate. Wool tends to return to its original shape and gets slightly larger over time.
